GLOBE JUSTICE OF THE PEACE RESIGNS

PHOENIX. The Commission on Judicial Conduct announced that it has concluded formal disciplinary proceedings against Justice of the Peace Patty Nolan based on a stipulated resolution in which the judge voluntarily agreed to resign from her position effective July 30, 2010. The commission also filed a recommendation with the Arizona Supreme Court to censure the judge for her misconduct in office. More specific information about the case may be obtained from the commission's office.

The commission is an independent state agency composed of six judges, two attorneys, and three public members with responsibility for investigating complaints against judges. Its office is located in the Arizona State Courts Building at the State Capitol complex in Phoenix.
